What cabinet styles do you offer?

All millwork is designed/specified by the architect, and Condit works with the GC to produce based on their designs and specifications.

Do you have a specific “cabinet line” of products or is everything custom?

Condit crafts all custom furniture-grade millwork.

What materials do you typically use?

Condit utilizes any standard furniture-grade cabinet materials specified, including: melamine, plastic laminate, wood veneers (wood and metal), solid dimensional lumber, acrylics, and metal.

How is Condit different from a traditional cabinet maker?

Condit is not your typical millwork shop. We provide in-house, turn-key solutions to build and finish any custom woodwork design. Condit guarantees consistency and quality control with all functions under one roof! What services do you provide besides woodworking?
